Our History

Founded in 2006, Asheville on Bikes began as a group of 25 costumed cyclists who won a cash prize in Asheville's holiday parade. That prize became the nest egg for Asheville on Bikes' initial advocacy efforts, including community rides, bike valets, and many emails to city and county staff. 19 years later, Asheville on Bikes has become synonymous with bicycle advocacy in Western North Carolina. Our efforts to improve Asheville's bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure, encourage more people to ride bicycles for recreation and transportation, and make Asheville a safe, easy, and enjoyable city to ride a bike are succeeding, thanks to the support and hard work of our members and sponsors.





BIKE VALET PROGRAM

Asheville on Bikes (AoB) is looking for a sponsor for our new bike valet program! AoB will offer pop-up bike valet parking for a variety of Asheville events including (but not excluding):

- Get in Gear Fest
- Downtown After 5
- Forestry Camp
- · Bike In Cinema at New Belgium Brewing
- Asheville Community Concert with Steep Canyon Rangers
- AVL Fest
- Events at the Orange Peel, Asheville Yards, & The Outpost
- · Asheville Farmers' Markets.

This pop-up bike valet parking will allow event-goers to safely park their bicycles in a supervised corral capable of holding up to 200+ bikes. The valet works just like a coat check. AoB staff greets riders, checks in their bikes, and returns bikes to riders at the end of the event.

The bike valets are more than just bicycle parking. They serve as a bicycle social hub where people gather and socialize before the main event.

Bicycle valets can be set up in a variety of locations. We can park 200 bicycles in the same space that's allocated for 10 cars. Bike valets maximize parking at events.

For each event AoB creates a route via AoB's Ride With GPS library to the event or venue so that participants can select a preferred route.



AoB's bike valet is a highly visible service that welcomes people who arrive by bike and provides secure, staffed parking throughout events. Presenting sponsors are featured directly on the bike valet kiosk — the first and last touchpoint for hundreds of riders — with prominent space to promote their brand, services, and offers.

Sponsors can use this space for a QR code linking to their website, a special offer for riders, or even a suggested bike route to their business. AoB collaborates with each presenting sponsor to design a custom kiosk poster that aligns with their goals and engages the cycling audience.

What Does the Ride Look Like?

Each ride follows the same schedule, with new venues featured every time. Follow the event on Facebook or sign up for our email newsletter for updates.

GATHER 5:30 PM - 6:00 PM

Participants will meet at a designated location in downtown Asheville. Here, AoB hosts will introduce the evening's participating businesses and help groups form based on where they'd like to go.

VENUE 6:15 PM - 7:00 PM

After a short ride through the city, each group will arrive at their chosen venue. At each location, an AoB bike valet will be ready to assist, allowing participants to enjoy their time without worrying about their bikes.

CULMINATE 7:15 PM - 9:00 PM

Following their visit, participants will hop back on their bikes for another ride around the city, culminating at a final venue where the fun continues.

YOUTH CYCLING PROGRAMS

Bike Club: Building Confident Young Riders

Bike Club is Asheville on Bikes' flagship youth program and a cornerstone of the Asheville City Schools Foundation's In Real Life afterschool initiative. We are proud to be the longest-running In Real Life program partner and the longest-running youth afterschool bicycle program in North Carolina.

Bike Club operates in three sessions each year:

- Spring & Fall: Hosted at Asheville Middle School in partnership with the Asheville City Schools Foundation.
- Summer: Coordinated with Youth Transformed for Life, a local nonprofit supporting youth in Asheville and Buncombe County in achieving their personal, educational, and professional goals.

Through collaboration with a variety of community partners, Bike Club is designed to expand cycling access and skills for middle school students. Each participant is paired with a trained coach and provided a quality bike, helmet, and signature vest. Over six to eight weeks, students learn to:

- Ride confidently and safely on city streets, greenways, and trails
- Maintain and operate their equipment
- Use a bike for both recreation and transportation

Bike Club blends practical education with plenty of safe riding experiences, ensuring every student gains confidence, skills, and joy on two wheels—while seeing their community from a new perspective.







AVL Unpaved Alliance led by AoB is dedicated to building two pilot natural surface trail systems to support better connections into the City's natural environments for Ashevillearea residents and its visitors in 2026. Users will be able to access this unpaved trail system via greenway, sidewalks, bike lanes, transit, and trailheads, providing "front door" access to trails. AoB holds the naming rights to the phase one trials and trailhead kiosks. If you're interested in sponsoring a trail or kiosk for three years, reach out to AoB.

BUILDING SMARTER INFRASTRUCTURE



Let's Build Safer Roads

I-26 Complete Street Design

Advocacy means speaking up and inspiring others to take specific actions. Asheville on Bikes (AoB) actively champions investments in complete streets, greenways, and trails to improve safety, accessibility, and mobility for all.

We collaborate with community members, the City of Asheville, and the North Carolina Department of Transportation to advance safety. The Merrimon Avenue project resulted in:

- A decrease in total collisions (down 23%)
- A decrease in collisions with injuries (down 30%)
- A decrease in motor vehicle speeds (down 3-5 mph)
- A shift in remaining crashes from frontal crashes to rear end crashes (frontal crashes down 55%)
- An increase in cycling use on the corridor (up 269%)
- A minimal increase in travel times for cars (up 2-14 seconds)

We are coordinating with the North Carolina Department of Transportation and the City of Asheville on the I-26 Connector and the Haywood Rd resurfacing to ensure active transportation facilities are prioritized.

Our advocacy extends to ongoing projects like the College & Patton Avenues and AVL Unpaved, as well as the Hellbender Regional Trail. As we rebuild transportation systems along the Swannanoa and French Broad Rivers, AoB is pushing for the inclusion of greenways and trails to establish regional active connections,

We've made our voices heard at Asheville City Council meetings, the Multi-Modal Transportation Commission, and the French Broad River MPO. We've engaged local groups, written letters to the governor, and taken our advocacy to Raleigh and Washington, D.C. as lobbyists. From calls and emails to stamped letters, we leave no stone unturned in our efforts to make Asheville the safest place in North Carolina to ride a bike.

Our dedication has not gone unnoticed. In 2020, the League of American Bicyclists named Asheville on Bikes the "Bicycle Advocacy Organization of the Year" and in 2025 our quick build project was recognized by National Association of City Transportation Officials in their recent publication, "Designing Streets for Kids."

Get There Asheville

Every election cycle, Asheville on Bikes hosts Get There AVL, a public candidate forum focusing on Asheville transportation systems and issues. Our forums allow candidates to share their perspective on transportation issues in Asheville, and citizens have the opportunity to talk with each of the candidates in a relaxed, town hall setting. Our forums are well attended by both candidates and citizens.

We also survey general election candidates, asking for their thoughts on multi-modal transportation in Asheville, and publish their answers on our website.

Our Get There AVL forums draw the largest attendance of all the local candidate forums—it's clear that our community cares about transportation issues in Asheville.






RIDE WITH GPS ROUTE LIBRARY

Bike riders can access community ride routes on the AoB Ride With GPS account. Bike riders can preview before an AoB event or download turn-by-turn directions to find new routes to ride on their own. Each route averages 1,500 annual views. Debuted in 2019, this program helps Asheville bike riders identify safe, pre-ridden routes based on their skill level and even whether they have kids.











